An Ordinance

Regulating the setting of curbs, constructing of gutters, laying of pavements, and removing of fences, in the Borough of Alburttis.

Section I. Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Alburttis, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that all property owners, tenants, lessees and occupiers of real estate in the Borough of Alburttis may at any time be compelled to construct curbs and gutters and lay pavements, of such material as the Borough may specify, upon five days' notice.

Section II. All persons desiring to lay pavements and construct curbs and gutters shall first get a permit from the Borough, and lay said pavements and construct said curbs and gutters according to the grade and regulations specified by the Borough.

Section III. All persons shall be required to set back their fences according to the Borough regulations, on five days' notice.

Section IV. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Burgess or one of the Justices of the Peace of the

Borough, be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and in default of payment of the same, committed to the Lehigh County prison one day for each dollar of fine imposed. Enacted into an ordinance at Alburtis, Pa., this fourteenth day of July A. D. 1914.
