

Ordinance No. 34.

An Ordinance relating to tax rate, budget, salaries, officers, appointees, expenditures and general financial affairs of the Borough of Alburtis.

Be it enacted by the Borough of Alburtis, as follows:

Section 1. That the tax rate of the Borough for the year 1937 be fixed at sixteen mills, nine mills thereof for general purposes and seven mills thereof to pay electoral debt service (retirement, interest and state tax); provided, that if the sinking fund levies shall not be sufficient, then additional funds therefor are hereby appropriated from the general fund; provided, further, that order for debt service shall be furnished to the Treasurer as needed and thereafter reported to council as it may require.

Section 2. The annual salaries, payable annually, of the following officers be fixed as follows: Burgess, \$25.00; Secretary \$100.00; Treasurer \$25.00 and Solicitor, \$50.00.

Section 3. That the following extraordinary expenditures and purchases be authorized and the amounts thereof set aside therefor, to be paid out of funds now in the treasury, current revenues or loans to be repaid from current revenues; provided, that all necessary legal requirements in relation to such expenditures be complied with.

(a) Purchases for emergency renovations and corrections to the water system, not to exceed seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars, in connection with the Federal Grant of funds.
