- § 97-1. Obstructing street crossing by standing locomotive.

No person shall obstruct any street crossing within borough limits by locomotive engine or railroad cars not in motion for a period longer than five (5) minutes.

- § 97-2. Obstructing street crossing by closed crossing gates.

No person shall keep any gates closed at grade crossings for a period longer than five (5) minutes.

- § 97-3. Duration of sound waves from locomotives.

No locomotives or railroad cars shall be permitted to stand within the Borough of Alburdis emitting low- or high-frequency sound waves by virtue of physical operation of the railroad car or auxiliary equipment thereon for a period in excess of three (3) hours.

§ 97-4. Violations and penalties.

Any person or persons found in violation of this chapter in a summary proceeding before a District Justice shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.).
