

ORDINANCE NO. 255

PROVIDING FOR LOCATION, ADOPTION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ALIGNMENT, WIDTHS AND GRADES FOR AMBER ALLEY LOCATED IN THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS ACCORDING TO A PLAN PREPARED BY MARTIN, BRADBURY & GRIFFITH, INC., CONSULTING ENGINEERS FOR THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS.

BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That thoroughfare known as Amber Alley be and hereby is adopted by the Borough of Alburtis and shall become a part of the Borough Street Plan, said alley more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a corner, said corner being the most southwesterly corner of the property of now or late Lawrence A. and Elizabeth A. Deiter, said corner also being a point on the northerly curb line of Franklin Street:

Thence, along the easterly property line of now or late Lawrence A. and Elizabeth A. Deiter, North 30° 30' 00" East, 200.00 feet to a corner located on the southerly property line of East Stone Alley; thence, along the same, South 66° 00' 00" East, 15.10 feet to a corner; thence, along the westerly property line of now or late Edward and Philberta Ewing, South 30° 30' 00" West, 198.73 feet to a corner located on the northerly curb line of Franklin Street; thence, along the same, North 70° 45' 00" West, 15.29 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3,064 square feet.

SECTION II: Amber Alley is hereby entered upon and made a part of the Official Street Map of the Borough of Alburtis, adopted May 9, 1979, by Ordinance No. 204 of the Borough of Alburtis.
