

ORDINANCE NO. 272

ORDINANCE BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE PUBLIC USAGE OF PROPERTY OWNED BY THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS.

In order to promote the safety and enjoyment of the public on property owned by the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the same, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of this Ordinance, Recreation Places shall mean and include all parks, playgrounds, baseball fields, and the tot lots now or hereafter owned or maintained by the Borough of Alburtis.

Section 2. The said Recreation Places are for the use, enjoyment and benefit of the public subject to the rules and regulations set forth herein.

Section 3. All other property owned by the Borough of Alburtis with the exception of Borough Hall, shall not be available for the use or benefit of the public without prior approval of Borough Council. Borough Hall shall be open to the public for the conducting of business during the days and hours set by Borough Council from time to time.

Section 4. Recreation Places may be closed during such hours as Borough Council may deem appropriate, and all persons found within said Recreation Place(s) during these hours shall be subject to penalties herein provided.

Section 5. Upon all Recreation Places, the following rules and regulations shall apply.

1. No person shall be in possession of or drink any alcoholic beverage(s).
2. No person shall be intoxicated.
3. No person shall possess or use glass containers.
4. No person shall commit any disorderly or immoral act.
5. No person shall ride or operate any bicycle, skateboard, all terrain vehicle, or any unauthorized vehicle onto the said property.
6. No person shall post any signs without prior approval by Borough Council.

7. No person shall use, profane or obscene language which would create the risk of public inconvenience, annoyance, alarm or incitation of lawless behavior.
8. No person shall sleep on the ground or elsewhere, except in such places and at such times which may be designated by the Borough Council.
9. No vehicle can be repaired mechanically, washed, painted, or have any other work performed on it within the confines of the Borough property.
10. Cutting, mutilating, removing, or taking away of trees, shrubs, or flowers, or the removal, defacing, or damaging of any park or recreational area property is prohibited.
11. Motor vehicles may not be parked within the parks or recreational areas except in designated parking areas.
12. No persons shall violate any further rules and regulations adopted by Borough Council, provided such rules and regulations are posted at least

seven days in advance in Borough Hall and in the Recreation Place to which they apply.

Section 6. In addition to the rules and regulations set forth in Section 5 herein, the following rules and regulations shall apply to the playground owned and maintained by the Borough of Alburtis located at East Stone Alley and Iron Alley:

1. Eating of food shall occur only in the picnic areas designated by the Borough. No cooking of food is permitted.
2. There shall be smoking permitted only in the picnic areas.
3. No animals are allowed in the park or recreational areas unless hand-controlled by a leash. The individual in charge of an animal entering this recreational area is required to be in possession of proper implements for the gathering and disposing of animal feces. All feces will be collected immediately, removed from the park or recreational area, and disposed of in accordance with accepted sanitary standards.

Section 7. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and, upon consideration thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not more than THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00), together with costs of prosecution, and in default of payment, thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
