**BE IT ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- § 4. Duties. All Borough officers and employees shall perform those duties assigned to them by law, by ordinance, resolution, or motion of Borough Council, and from time to time, by the President of Borough Council (or, in the case of the Police Department, by the Mayor).
