Ordinance No. 371

(Duly Adopted August 11, 1999)

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE SOUTHERLY
SIDE OF COBBLESTONE COURT.

WHEREAS, Sections 3353(d), and 6109(a)(1), (b), (d), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. §§ 3353(d), 6109(a)(1),(b),(d),(e), and chapters 201 (in particular § 201.21) and 211 (in particular § 211.6) of the Transportation Department regulations, title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code, permit municipalities to prohibit, regulate, limit, or restrict stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway within their physical boundaries, if the designation is made by ordinance, and, with regard to certain regulations, in accordance with an engineering and traffic investigation which complies with state regulations; and

WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic investigation discloses that the street width of Cobblestone Court is such that one of two vehicles moving abreast of one another in the same or opposite direction and passing vehicles parked along one or both curb faces or edges of the roadway is required to yield to allow the other vehicle to pass; and

WHEREAS, this condition permits the Borough to restrict stopping, standing, and parking in the affected area under the state regulations (67 PA. CODE § 201.21(b)(2)); and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined that parking in the area described below impedes the flow of traffic and creates a safety hazard, particularly since Cobblestone Court is narrow and curves in a semi-circle, and that restricting parking on the Southerly side of Cobblestone Court is less inconvenient for neighborhood residents than restricting parking on the Northerly side of Cobblestone Court;

Now, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 129-25(A)(7) of the Code of the Borough of Alburdis (relating to Stopping, Standing, and Parking Restrictions—No Parking Zones—Cobblestone Court), as added by Ordinance 317 (adopted July 12, 1995), shall be amended as follows (with deletions indicated in ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by double underlining):

7. Cobblestone Court,
southerly side (or the side on the outside of the semicircle),
entire length of street.
~~from the westernmost intersection of Cobblestone Court and
East Second Street
to the point which is one hundred sixty five (165) feet
to the south (measured along the southern curblines of
Cobblestone Court
of the southern curblines of East Second Street
at the easternmost intersection of Cobblestone Court and
East Second Street.~~

SECTION 2. The Borough shall erect and/or maintain official traffic control devices at all locations ordained under § 129-25 of the Code of the Borough of Alburdis, as amended by Section 1 of this Ordinance, in accordance with regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
