AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, BONDS, AND DUTIES OF BOROUGH OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 2001.

**BE IT ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

§ 1. Salaries and Rates of Compensation. The following salaries and rates of compensation are hereby established for the year 2001 for the offices and positions of employment set forth below:

- § 4. Duties. All Borough officers and employees shall perform those duties assigned to them by law, by ordinance, resolution, or motion of Borough Council, and from

ment, by the Ma	ayor).			

§ 5. Repealer. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
