AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, BONDS, AND DUTIES OF BOROUGH OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 2002.

BE IT ORDAINED and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

§ 1. Salaries and Rates of Compensation. The following salaries and rates of compensation are hereby established for the year 2002 for the offices and positions of employment set forth below:
