Ordinance No. 510

(Duly Adopted September 11, 2013)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 41-802 OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO DESIGNATE A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON THE EAST SIDE OF FRANKLIN STREET IN THE VICINITY OF 211 SOUTH MAIN STREET UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2016, UNLESS TERMINATED SOONER BY COUNCIL, AND TO EXTEND THE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES IN THE VICINITY OF 344 FRANKLIN STREET, 329 WALNUT STREET, AND 31 WEST THIRD STREET UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2016, UNLESS TERMINATED SOONER BY COUNCIL; AND AMENDING SECTION 41-1001 TO DESIGNATE CHESTNUT STREET FROM THIRD STREET TO SCHOOL STREET AS A SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE.

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council has received an application for a handicapped parking space to accommodate the parking needs of a person with a disability; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to establish such a handicapped parking space for a limited period of time; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to extend the handicapped parking spaces in the vicinity of 344 Franklin Street, 329 Walnut Street, and 31 West Third Street for a limited period of time to continue to accommodate the parking needs of persons with a disability; and

**WHEREAS**, Sections 6109(a)(1) and (7) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. § 6109(a)(1),(7), permit municipalities to regulate or prohibit stopping, standing, or parking, and to prohibit or restrict the use of highways at particular places or by particular classes of vehicles whenever the highway may be seriously damaged by the use or the movement of the vehicles would constitute a safety hazard, and Section 212.114(f)(1)(iv) and (h) of the Transportation Department regulations, 67 Pa. Code § 212.114(f)(1)(iv)

and (h), permits municipalities to designate snow emergency routes on local or state highways within their physical boundaries without an engineering or traffic study; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to establish Chestnut Street from Third Street to School Street as an additional snow emergency route; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 4, 2013, the Borough published a public notice in the *East Penn Press*, a newspaper of general circulation in the Borough of Alburdis, of its intention to consider and adopt on this Ordinance on September 11, 2013;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Codified Ordinances § 41-802 (relating to Traffic Control—Handicapped Parking Spaces—Designated Spaces) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by double underlining):

**§ 41-802 Designated Spaces.**

The following spaces are designated handicapped parking spaces. A particular disabled person is identified for each space, and the designation shall remain in effect until the expiration date for that space, unless terminated sooner by motion or resolution of Council. Unless otherwise indicated below, the length of the space shall be twenty-two (22) feet, and the center of the space shall be the point where the street curblin intersects the center-line of the sidewalk or other access-way used by the disabled person to access the dwelling on the designated property:

**SECTION 2.** Codified Ordinances § 41-1001 (relating to Traffic Control—Snow Emergencies—Designation of Snow Emergency Routes) is amended by revising line 3A as follows (with deletions indicated by ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by double underlining):

**§ 41-1001 Designation of Snow Emergency Routes.**

The following streets are hereby designated snow emergency routes within the Borough:

**SECTION 3.** As provided in Codified Ordinances § 41-104 (relating to Traffic Control—General Provisions—Official Signs), the Borough shall erect and maintain official traffic control devices for all locations ordained under Codified Ordinances §§ 41-802 and 41-1001, as amended by this Ordinance, in accordance with regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; and as provided in Codified Ordinances §

41-803 (relating to Traffic Control—Handicapped Parking Spaces—Signs), all official traffic control devices erected and maintained in connection with the handicapped parking spaces designated under this Ordinance shall state the penalty provided by law for violations and state that vehicles in violation may be towed.
