

Ordinance No. 36

To levy and collect an annual water tax in the Borough of Alburdis,
Lehigh County, Pa.

Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the Borough of
Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained
and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the annual water rents or tax for the Borough
of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, are fixed and to be charged
on the following basis:

Domestic Use:	Per Annum
(a) Dwellings, each for private use only	\$ 12.00
(b) One or more exterior outlets or spigots to a building or dwelling	2.00
(c) Filling cisterns, per each filling	15.00
(d) Farms, for horses and cattle only	15.00
(e) Poultry farms	5.00
(f) Private swimming pools	36.00
(g) For service outside the Borough, double the rate for the same classifications as exist within Borough.	
Commercial Use:	
(a) Hotels, soda fountains, restaurants, etc.	24.00
(b) Stores, barber shops, meat markets, bakeries, ware- houses, etc., additional when on the same premises and operated by same person that occupies the building or dwelling	5.00
(c) Lodge halls, club rooms, churches, schools	12.00
(d) Public garages, slaughter houses, etc.,	36.00
(e) Stores, barber shops, meat markets, bakeries, ware- houses, etc., when not on same premises or not operated by owner of such premises and not within classification (b)	12.00
(f) For service outside the Borough, double the rate for the same classifications as exist within the Borough.	

Industrial Use:

(a) Factories and like industrial or manufacturing plants \$ 60.00

Public Fire Protection:

(a) Applicable only to non-consumers, i.e. dwellings, properties or buildings, including commercial and industrial establishments 5.20

Section 2. Water rent shall be payable semi-annually on the first day of May and November of each year. On water rents paid on or before the first day of June and December, there shall be allowed a discount of fifty (50%) per cent. After the first day of June and December the full amount shall be due and payable.

Section 3. If the water rent remains unpaid for sixty (60) days after the first day of May and November, the Borough Council may direct the Superintendent of the Water Department to disconnect and discontinue the supply of water until the arrearages have been paid; the same shall not be connected and no water shall be supplied until all arrearages and costs have been paid.
