

ORDINANCE NO. 59

Regulating traffic and certain uses of the highways generally in the Borough of Alburtis.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Alburtis that from and after the passage of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, whether principal or agent, to violate or fail to comply with the following regulations pertaining to the traffic and uses in the highways of the Borough of Alburtis under the penalties herein provided:

1. When possible to avoid, no person shall cause traffic to be obstructed, interfered with or annoyed, or shall cause danger, annoyance, discomfort, or inconvenience to any person, or injury to person or property.

2. No parking is permitted on the streets of the Borough or sections thereof where signs or lines designating such prohibition are placed or posted.

3. It shall be lawful for the Borough to paint curbs and other lines, place any pedestals, posts, signs, lights, wires or other fixtures or apparatus on, under or over the highways of the Borough by direction of the Borough Council or approved by it.

4. No persons shall place any signs or paint any curb to regulate traffic in highways except under proper municipal authority, and after approval of the Borough Council or other person designated by Council.

5. The Chief of Police may, with the assistance of the Borough police or other employees, for special temporary purposes, restrict, or prohibit all traffic and parking on particular highways or parts thereof, where otherwise it would be permitted; or may permit traffic and parking on particular highways or parts thereof where otherwise it would be prohibited. Such temporary special occasions shall include time allowed for painting of lines, parades, exhibitions, demonstrations, celebrations and other similar uses, and like permission or prohibition may be imposed or granted where special temporary uses are being made in premises immediately adjoining the highway wherein unusual usages of the highway may be deemed necessary. No traffic shall interfere with the provisions of this section.

6. All persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) or more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense, and each daily occurrence of the same offense shall be considered a new offense and finable as such. In default of payment of the fine the offender shall be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

Section 2. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
