

ORDINANCE NO. 97

Prohibiting and regulating the running at large of animals upon the streets, alleys, parks or squares of the Borough of Alburttis and providing penalties for violation.

SECTION I BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the borough of Alburttis, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, whether the owner or person in possession or in control of any animals in the Borough of Alburttis, to permit the running at large upon the streets, alleys, parks or squares of the borough of any such animal or animals owned by, in possession of, or under control of, the said owner or person.

SECTION II All animals so running at large upon the streets, alleys, parks or squares shall be subject to seizure under direction of the Mayor and such animals seized shall be disposed of by sale for the benefit of the borough or turned over to a Humane Society for disposition as they deem fit.

SECTION III No domestic animals shall be permitted upon the streets, alleys, parks or squares of the borough unless under leash and when accompanied by a person who shall prevent the annoyance of the traveling public by such domestic animal or animals.

SECTION IV Any owner of an animal or animals violating or permitting the violation of any of the provisions hereof shall be subject to a penalty of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, to be recovered as penalties are now recoverable by law.

SECTION V All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
