

ORDINANCE NO. 98

Prohibiting and regulating nonessential use or uses of water supplied by the Borough of Alburtis during a period which the Borough of Alburtis has declared to be a water shortage emergency period and providing penalties for violation.

SECTION I BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance, during that period of time declared to be a Water Shortage Emergency Period by a Resolution of Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation to use water supplied by the Borough of Alburtis for nonessential uses. The Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis declares the following uses to be nonessential uses: Washing motor vehicles; watering, sprinkling or irrigation of lawns, gardens, trees, shrubs, flowers, flower beds, fields and/or crops; washing or watering in any manner whatsoever, sidewalks, pavements, streets, porches, steps and/or buildings; running water into any swimming or wading pool of any description whatsoever; any use for recreational or aesthetic purposes; or any unnecessary waste of any kind whatsoever.

SECTION II Any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation violating any of the provisions hereof shall, for the first offense, be subject to a penalty of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00), to be recovered as penalties are now recoverable by law. Upon a second and subsequent violation of the provisions hereof by the same party during the same water shortage emergency period, the superintendent of the Water Department is directed to shut off the water to the premises of the party violating such provision and to restore water service to the subject premises only when all costs involved in the shutting off of the water service and restoration of the water service have been paid and a permit for such restoration of service has been requested in writing by the party violating such provision hereof. Each nonessential use as defined in this Ordinance is a separate offense and any nonessential use as defined in this Ordinance persisted in after notice from the Superintendent of the Water Department shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION III The Superintendent of the Water Department, or any other person acting under an order from him, shall and is hereby authorized and empowered, upon written request prior to the contemplated non-essential use as defined in this Ordinance which is in violation of this Ordinance from any party aggrieved by the enforcement of this Ordinance, to issue a letter of essential sanitary use permitting such party to use water for a nonessential purpose or use as defined in this Ordinance. Any party aggrieved by the decision of the Superintendent of the Water Department has a right to appeal to the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis within ten (10) days after such decision.

SECTION IV This Ordinance is hereby declared to be urgent, and shall take effect immediately upon the passage hereof.
