

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN "SNOW ROUTES" AND REGULATIONS FOR THEIR USE UNDER SNOW EMERGENCIES.

SECTION I. The following streets are hereby designated "Snow Emergency Routes" within the Borough of Alburtis within the meaning and intentment of this ordinance:

- (a) Walnut Street from Front Street to School Street.
- (b) Penn Avenue from Main Street to Oak Street.
- (c) Main Street from the Northern Borough line to School Street.
- (d) School Street from Walnut Street to Franklin Street.
- (e) Second Street from Main Street to Walnut Street.
- (f) Third Street from Main Street to Walnut Street.
- (g) Franklin Street from Main Street to the Southern Borough line.

SECTION II. All "Snow Emergency Routes" shall be marked by signs conforming to Pennsylvania State Highway Department standards and placed at the intersection of major streets.

SECTION III. Signs designating "Snow Emergency Routes" shall be temporarily placed or attached to poles or trees located with the public easement area for pedestrians. Said signs shall be maintained from November 15th to the following March 15th, whereupon they shall be removed by the Borough.

SECTION IV. All vehicles parked on streets designated as "Snow Emergency Routes" between November 15th and March 15th next following shall be subject to removal without notice by the Borough of Alburtis upon the proclamation of a "Snow Emergency" by the Mayor or by Borough Council.

SECTION V. A condition of "Snow Emergency" shall be deemed to exist when as a result of the quantity of fallen or blowing snow on Borough Streets the normal operation of Borough snow removal equipment has been hampered or delayed as to affect the safety and welfare of the public. It shall be the duty of Borough Council, if in session, or the Mayor, after due consultation with the Police Department, to make public announcement at repeated intervals and by appropriate available method, of the existence of such condition.


SECTION VI. Any vehicle required to be removed by the Borough of Alburtis after the declaration of a "Snow Emergency" shall be returned to the possession of the owner upon payment by the owner of costs of removal.

SECTION VII. Any vehicle found to impede the Borough of Alburttis in the removal of snow from "Snow Emergency Routes" following the proclamation of a "Snow Emergency" shall be deemed to constitute a nuisance and illegally parked and subject the owner to liability and penalty there for.
