

ORDINANCE NO. 144

It is hereby Ordained under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council for the BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS:

SECTION I: All swimming pools to be constructed or which have already been constructed within the Borough of Alburdis shall be enclosed by a fence which shall be at least four (4) feet in height and shall be of such type or construction that is not readily climbed by small children. Ingress and egress to and from the pool enclosure shall be by gate equipped with a self closing latch affixed on the pool side.

SECTION II: Inasmuch as the intention of this ordinance is to set minimum standards for the protection of small children from the risks invitingly offered by unguarded swimming pools, a natural barrier, hedge, pool-cover or other protective device offering equivalent protection as that described in Section I shall be acceptable under the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION III: The Borough Zoning Officer is charged with the enforcement of the terms of this ordinance and hereby authorized to make such inspection of premises within the Borough as shall be necessary to exact compliance with this ordinance.

SECTION IV: The owners of swimming pools presently constructed shall comply with the terms of this ordinance within 60 days from the passage thereof.

SECTION V: Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$300.00 and costs of suit; or, upon failure to pay the same to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed five (5) days at the discretion of the magistrate who shall hear the case.
