

ORDINANCE NO. 179A

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE INTERRUPTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON BOROUGH STREETS BY RAILROAD CARS AND ENGINES AND THE PARKING OF RAILROAD CARS INSIDE THE BOROUGH FOR EXTENDED PERIODS OF TIME EMITTING HIGH OR LOW FREQUENCY SOUND AT EXTENDED LEVELS OR FOR EXTREME DURATION.

The Borough of Alburtis hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I. No person shall obstruct any street crossing within Borough limits by locomotive engine or railroad cars not in motion for a period longer than five (5) minutes.


SECTION II. No person shall keep any gates closed at grade crossings for a period longer than five (5) minutes.

SECTION III. No locomotives or railroad cars shall be permitted to stand within the Borough of Alburtis emitting low or high frequency sound waves by virtue of physical operation of the railroad car or auxiliary equipment thereon for a period in excess of three (3) hours.


SECTION IV. Any person or persons found in violation of this Ordinance by a summary proceeding before a Magistrate shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.
