

ORDINANCE No. 187

AN ORDINANCE providing for the location, adoption and establishment of the alignment and width of a portion of Second Street in the Borough of Alburdis.

SECTION I. A public thoroughfare known as a portion of Second Street from its intersection with Walnut Street, westwardly to its intersection with Tin Alley, be and hereby is adopted by the Borough of Alburdis and shall become a part of the Borough Street Plan, said street more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point of intersection formed by westerly right-of-way line of Walnut Street extended with the centerline of Second Street; thence along the centerline of Second Street a distance of approximately 263 feet to the point of intersection formed by the easterly right of way line of Tin Alley and the centerline of Second Street.

Being of a uniform total width of 50.00 feet, a cartway width of 30.00 feet and curb and sidewalk area of 10.00 feet on each side.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an ordinance by the Borough of Alburdis in Council assembled this 10th day of August, 1977.
