ORDINANCE NO. 285

(DULY ADOPTED July 31, 1991)

ORDINANCE BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
ALBURTIS, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING
THE CONTROL OF ANIMALS ON RECREATIONAL PROPERTY
OWNED OR BEING MAINTAINED BY THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 272, adopted October 11, 1989, the
Borough of Alburtis established certain rules and regulations
regulating recreational areas owned or maintained by the Borough
of Alburtis; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to extend the animal control
provisions of Ordinance No. 272 to all recreational places owned
or maintained by the Borough of Alburtis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough
Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania,
in lawful session duly assembled:

Section 1. Section 5, paragraph 12 of Ordinance No. 272 shall
be redesignated as paragraph 13.

Section 2. The following new paragraph 12 is hereby added
to Section 5 of Ordinance No. 272:

12. No domesticated animals are allowed in the
Recreational Places unless hand-controlled by a
leash. The individual in charge of an animal
entering any Recreational Place is required to be

in possession of proper implements for the gathering and disposing of animal feces. All feces will be collected immediately, removed from the Recreational Place, and disposed of in accordance with accepted sanitary standards.

Section 3. Section 6, paragraph 3 of Ordinance No. 272 is hereby deleted.
