Ordinance No. 290

(Duly Adopted April 8, 1992)

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS WITHIN
THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS.

WHEREAS, Section 6109(a)(6), (b), (d), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. § 6109(a)(6),(b),(d),(e), and chapters 201 (in particular § 201.52) and 211 (in particular § 211.6) of the Transportation Department regulations, title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code, permits municipalities to designate any intersection of two roadways as a stop intersection, if the designation is made by ordinance and in accordance with an engineering and traffic investigation which complies with state regulations, *provided that* the state Department of Transportation approves of the designation with respect to the intersection of two state highways or a state highway and a local highway; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has conducted engineering and traffic investigations under the state regulations and concluded that stop intersections are warranted and should be established as set forth in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has approved or established those stop intersections set forth in this Ordinance which involve at least one state highway, or those restrictions were duly posted or erected before July 1, 1977 (and so do not require additional approval under 67 PA. CODE § 201.3(c)).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 129 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis shall be amended by adding thereto the following new Article V:

**ARTICLE V
Traffic Control**

§ 129-20. Short Title.

This Article shall be known and may be referred to as the "Alburtis Traffic Control Ordinance."
