BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Ordinance No. 292

(Duly Adopted July 8, 1992)

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE INTERSECTION OF WAL-NUT STREETS AND WEST SECOND STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS AS A FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, Section 6109(a)(6), (b), (d), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. § 6109(a)(6),(b),(d),(e), and chapters 201 (in particular § 201.52) and 211 (in particular § 211.6) of the Transporation Department regulations, title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code, permits municipalities to designate any intersection of two roadways as a stop intersection, if the designation is made by ordinance and in accordance with an engineering and traffic investigation which complies with state regulations, *provided that* the state Department of Transportation approves of the designation with respect to the intersection of two state highways or a state highway and a local highway; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has conducted engineering and traffic investigations under the state regulations and concluded that a four-way stop intersection is warranted and should be established at the intersection of Walnut Street and West Second Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 129-24 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis, as recently added to the Code by Ordinance No. 281 (adopted April 8, 1992), shall be amended by *deleting* subsection A, paragraph 11 (relating to two-way stop sign at the intersection of Walnut and West Second Streets, with Walnut Street being a stop street and West Second

Street being a through street), **and** by *adding* the following new paragraph 4 to subsection B (relating to All-Way Stop Signs):

4. Walnut Street, West Second Street.

SECTION 2. The Borough shall erect and/or maintain official traffic control devices at the intersection of Walnut Street and West Second Street in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance and the regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
