## BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Ordinance No. 408

(Duly Adopted September 10, 2003)

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS: WEST SECOND STREET, EAST SECOND STREET, LOCKRIDGE LANE, RIDGEVIEW DRIVE, WALNUT STREET, SOUTH MAIN STREET (FROM FRANKLIN STREET TO SCHOOL STREET), AND SCHOOL STREET (FROM SOUTH MAIN STREET TO FRANKLIN STREET); AND CONFIRMING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF ALBURTIS: WEST PENN AVENUE, SCHOOL STREET (FROM SOUTH MAIN STREET TO OAK STREET), CHURCH STREET, AND THIRD STREET.

WHEREAS, Sections 3362(a)(1.2) and (b), and 6109(a)(10), (a)(11), (b), (d), and (e) of the Vehicle Code, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. §§ 3362(a)(1.2), (b), 6109(a)(10), (a)(11), (b), (d), (e), permit municipalities to establish a speed limit of 25 m.p.h. on any local highway within their physical boundaries which is in a residence district and not a numbered traffic route, without an engineering and traffic investigation, if adopted by ordinance and posted in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS,** certain local and residential streets within the Borough are already posted with 25 m.p.h. speed limit signs, and Borough Council desires to confirm the designation of those streets as having a maximum speed limit of 25 m.p.h.; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined that 25 m.p.h. maximum speed limits should also be established on certain other local and residential streets within the Borough;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 129-23 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis, as added and reserved by Ordinance 290 (adopted April 8, 1992), shall be amended to read as follows:

## § 129-23. Speed Limits.

The following speed limits are hereby established. Violations of these restrictions shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (*see*, *e.g.*, 75 PA. CONS. STAT. §§ 3362. 3363):

## A. <u>25 m.p.h. Zones</u>

The maximum speed limit shall be twenty-five miles per hour (25 m.p.h.) on the following streets at all times:

- 1. East Second Street, entire length.
- 2. West Second Street, entire length.
- 3. Third Street, entire length.
- 4. Church Street, entire length.
- 5. Lockridge Lane, entire length.
- 6. South Main Street, from Franklin Street to School Street.
- 7. West Penn Avenue, entire length.
- 8. Ridgeview Drive, entire length.
- 9. School Street, entire length.
- 10. Walnut Street, entire length.

**SECTION 2.** The Borough shall erect and/or maintain official speed limit traffic control devices for all streets subject to speed limits ordained under § 129-23 of the Code of the Borough of Alburtis, as amended by Section 1 of this Ordinance, in accordance with regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
