Ordinance No. 421

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 97-104 OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES (RELATING TO PEDDLING AND SOLICITING ORDINANCE—LICENSE REQUIRED) BY REPLACING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE MAYOR COUNTERSIGN A PEDDLING LICENSE WITH A REQUIREMENT THAT THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR HIS DESIGNATE SIGN EACH PEDDLING LICENSE.

Be it **Ordained** and **Enacted** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, that Codified Ordinances § 97-104 (relating to Business and Nonprofit Activities—Peddling and Soliciting—License Required) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by strike-outs and insertions indicated by double underlining):

§ 97-104 License Required.

No person shall engage in peddling in the Borough of Alburtis without first having taken out a license as provided by this Article. No peddlers license shall be valid without the signature of the Borough Secretary and the countersignature of the Mayor the Chief of Police or his designate.
