Ordinance No. 421

(Duly Adopted January 28, 2004)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 97-104 OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES (RELATING TO PEDDLING AND SOLICITING ORDINANCE—LICENSE REQUIRED) BY REPLACING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE MAYOR COUNTERSIGN A PEDDLING LICENSE WITH A REQUIREMENT THAT THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR HIS DESIGNATE SIGN EACH PEDDLING LICENSE.

Be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Al-
burtis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, that Codified Ordinances § 97-104 (relating to
Business and Nonprofit Activities—Peddling and Soliciting—License Required) is
amended as follows (with deletions indicated by ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by
double underlining):

§ 97-104 License Required.

No person shall engage in peddling in the Borough of Alburdis with-
out first having taken out a license as provided by this Article. No ped-
dlers license shall be valid without the signature of the Borough Secretary
and ~~the countersignature of the Mayor~~ the Chief of Police or his designate.
