Ordinance No. 456

(Duly Adopted January 10, 2007)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 41-802 OF THE ALBURTIS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO DESIGNATE A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON THE WEST SIDE OF FRANKLIN STREET ACROSS THE STREET FROM 333 FRANKLIN STREET UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008, UNLESS TERMINATED SOONER BY COUNCIL, AND TO EXTEND UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2008 THE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON THE EAST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET IN FRONT OF 329 WALNUT STREET, UNLESS TERMINATED SOONER BY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Borough Council has received an application for a handicapped parking space to accommodate the parking needs of a person with a disability; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to establish such a handicapped parking space for a limited period of time; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to extend the period for the handicapped parking space previously ordained in front of 329 Walnut Street to accommodate the parking needs of a person who continues to have a disability; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2007, the Borough published a public notice in the *East Penn Press*, a newspaper of general circulation in the Borough of Alburdis, of its intention to consider and adopt on this Ordinance on January 10, 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Alburdis, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Codified Ordinances § 41-802 (relating to Traffic Control—Handicapped Parking Spaces—Designated Spaces) is amended as follows (with deletions indicated by ~~strike-outs~~ and insertions indicated by double underlining):

§ 41-802 Designated Spaces.

The following spaces are designated handicapped parking spaces. A particular disabled person is identified for each space, and the designation shall remain in effect until the expiration date for that space, unless terminated sooner by motion or resolution of Council. Unless otherwise indicated below, the length of the space shall be twenty-two (22) feet, and the center of the space shall be the point where the street curblin intersects the center-line of the sidewalk or other access-way used by the disabled person to access the dwelling on the designated property:

1. <u>Mary Ann Bohlen</u>	<u>December 31, 2008</u>	<u>Franklin Street, Westerly Side</u>	<u>From the point on the curblin of Franklin Street which is the southern boundary of the driveway between 330 Franklin Street and 334 Franklin Street, to the point twenty-two (22) feet south of the starting point.</u>
2. <u>Michael Hoosier</u>	<u>September 30, 2005</u> <u>December 31, 2008</u>	<u>Walnut Street, Easterly Side</u>	<u>In front of 329 Walnut Street</u>

<u>Person</u>	<u>Expiration</u>	<u>Street/Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
3. Fay Oels	September 30, 2005	Chestnut Street, Westerly Side	From the point sixty (60) feet north of the northern curbline of West Second Street, to the point twenty-two (22) feet north of the starting point.
